The UCLA Center for Advancing Longitudinal Drug Abuse Research (CALDAR), in collaboration with the Asian & Pacific Islander Addiction Science Network, is pleased to announce the second meeting of the Conference Series to Promote Global Health, sponsored by the National Institute on Drug Abuse.

Conference Goals: (1) share research findings in the treatment and prevention of substance use disorders and HIV infection, (2) stimulate international collaborations, particularly between the US and the Asia/ Pacific Island Region, and (3) inform cultural aspects of treatment and prevention of substance use disorders and HIV, in order to promote global health.

Abstract submission is highly encouraged for all conference participants. Accepted abstracts will be included in a pre-conference special issue of the Journal of Neuroimmune Pharmacology. Abstracts are required for poster session and the Early Career investigator Stipends Award application.

To apply for the Early Career Investigator Conference Stipends, applicants must:

- Be a graduate student, post-doctoral fellow, or junior investigator who has obtained a Ph.D., M.D. or equivalent degree within the past 5 years
- Have submitted an abstract and completed conference registration
